Teachers use the platform to share academic feedback, suggestions, and student progress.

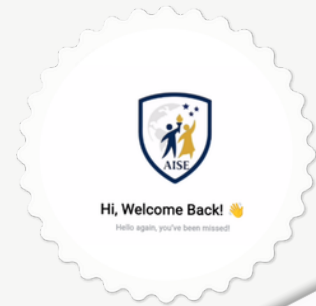
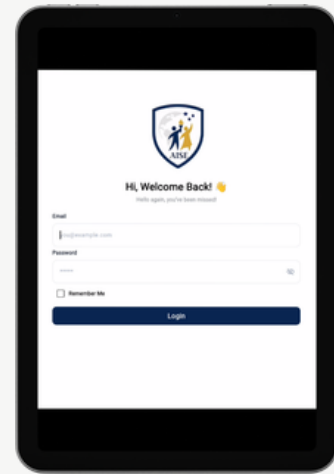
Using the Platform Effectively
