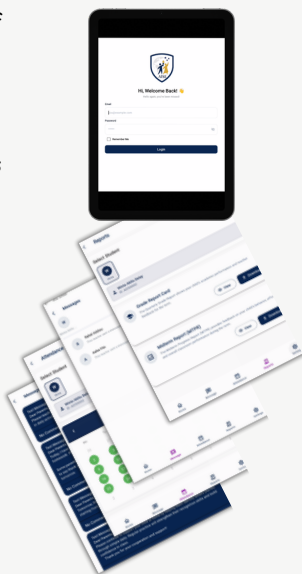
Welcome to the Parent-Teacher Conference at the American International School of Ethiopia (AISE).

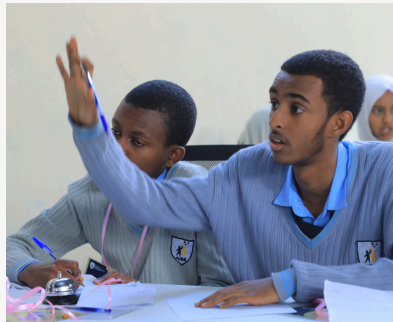
